When creating Events on the first step, there is a section called Special Guests. Here you can add up to 8 Special Guests.



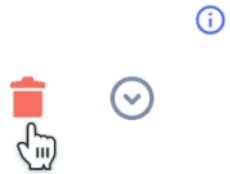

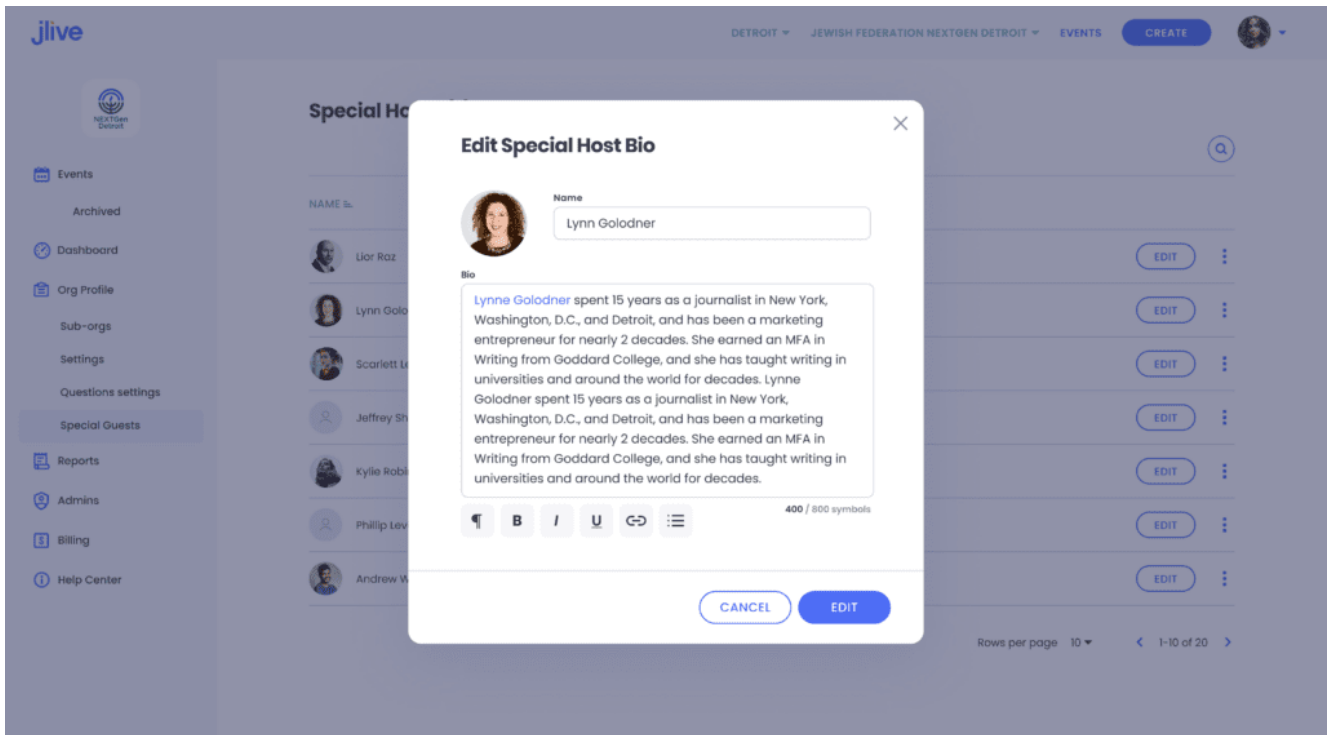

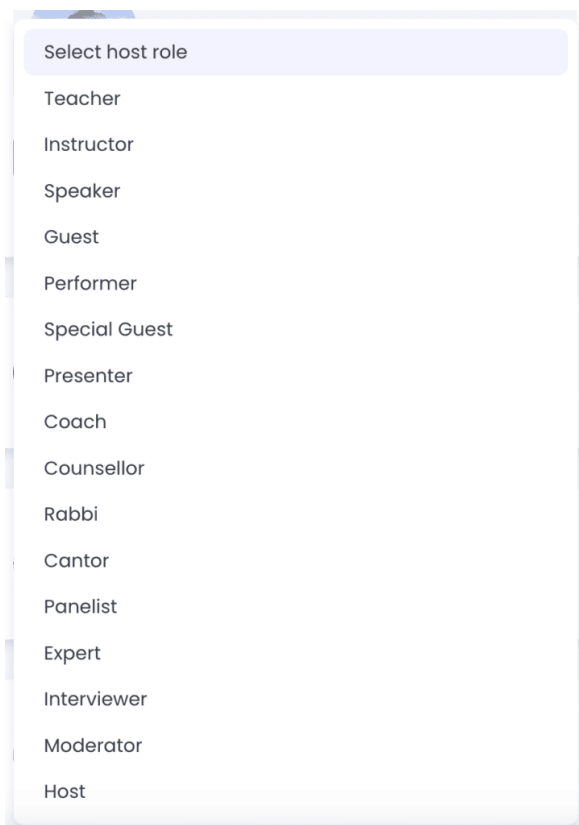

Organization-wide Special Hosts

Each Special Guest is available to any organization within your family of organizations. This means a child organization shares the same Special Guest Bio as the parent or grandparent organization. However, an unrelated organization

does not have access to your organization's Bios. So in theory, they could create their own Bio for the same person.
